

## MEASURING GUIDE

### Perfect grass chosen, now for the technical bit!

For any project, measuring accurately is key to its success. Our mantra has always been **'measure twice, cut once'** a winning formula that has never let us down.

Before purchasing, use this guide to assist you in calculating how much grass you require. We know all gardens are different shapes and sizes so have included examples to help you achieve the ideal outcome. If you need any further advice or assistance please get in touch.

### IMPORTANT MEASURING TIPS

All of our grasses come in 1m, 2m, 3m, 4m and 5m widths so try to choose a combination to minimise the number of joins.

When calculating the total width of grass required, please bear in mind that you will lose approx. 10cm on each join.

When measuring the length, consider all grasses are sold in 0.5m increments, remember to add a little extra to allow for trimming and any size discrepancy. We advise rounding up to the nearest half metre in your final measurements.

# MEASURING GUIDE

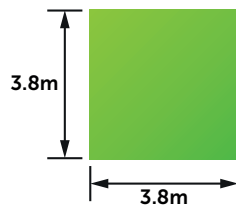
## SMALL SQUARE SHAPE

Easy to measure, simply multiply the length by the width.

### GRASS REQUIRED

4m width x 4m depth

**Total = 16m<sup>2</sup>**



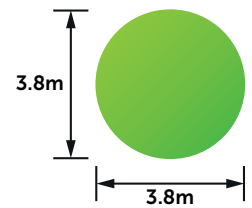
## SMALL CIRCULAR SHAPE

Measure the same way you would a square lawn.

### GRASS REQUIRED

4m width x 4m depth

**Total = 16m<sup>2</sup>**



## L - SHAPE

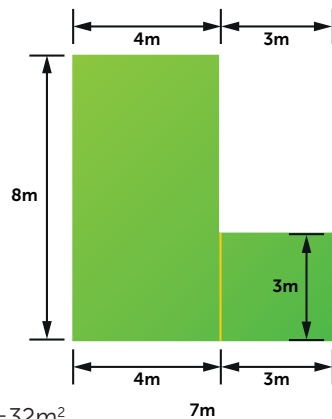
Find where your joint is going to be (yellow line) and measure both rectangles as shown

### GRASS REQUIRED

Roll 1 = 8m Long x 4m wide = 32m<sup>2</sup>

Roll 2 = 3m Long x 3m wide = 9m<sup>2</sup>

**Total = 41m<sup>2</sup>**



## TRIANGLE SHAPE

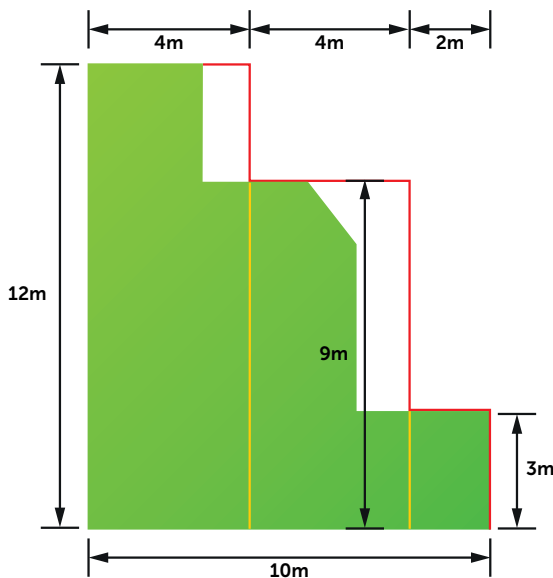
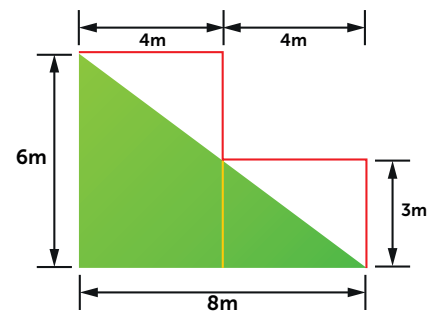
Here, work out where the joint falls (yellow line) falls at the 4m wide point before measuring as two rectangles (see red lines). As with all triangles, you will have a lot left over with this type of installation

### GRASS REQUIRED

Roll 1 = 6m Long x 4m wide = 24m<sup>2</sup>

Roll 2 = 3m Long x 4m wide = 12m<sup>2</sup>

**Total = 36m<sup>2</sup>**



## LARGE STEPPED SHAPE

The first thing you need to establish is where the joints fall (yellow lines) are and what roll widths you require to cover your entire garden area. Based on the example you would need to order three rectangular pieces. See red lines.

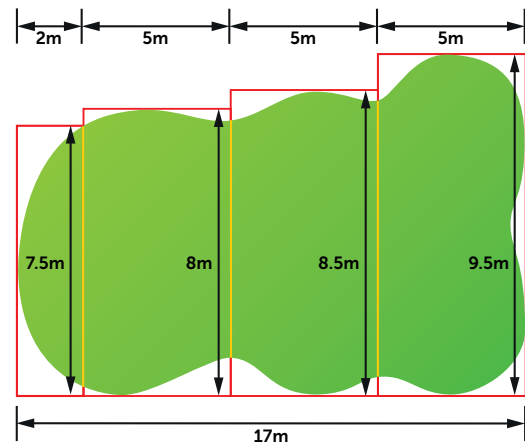
### GRASS REQUIRED

Roll 1 = 12m Long x 4m wide = 48m<sup>2</sup>

Roll 2 = 9m Long x 4m wide = 36m<sup>2</sup>

Roll 3 = 3m Long x 2m wide = 6m<sup>2</sup>

**Total = 90m<sup>2</sup>**



## LARGE IRREGULAR SHAPE

The first thing to establish is where the joints fall (yellow lines). Then you can work out what roll widths are required to achieve full coverage.

Measure each section at its widest/longest point and then break down your order into several rectangular pieces (see red lines).

### GRASS REQUIRED

Roll 1 = 9.5m Long x 5m wide = 47.5m<sup>2</sup>

Roll 2 = 8.5m Long x 5m wide = 42.5m<sup>2</sup>

Roll 3 = 8m Long x 5m wide = 40m<sup>2</sup>

Roll 4 = 7.5m Long x 2m wide = 15m<sup>2</sup>

**Total = 145m<sup>2</sup>**
